APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Please have all documents and answers to the questions ready to upload before entering the information. This application does not have a save feature. Any information Placed on this Form will not be saved if you end your session before completing. Successful applications must meet the following criteria to qualify:

- Currently a female student enrolled as a Senior in High School
- A resident of Colorado, Missouri or Oklahoma (one student from each state)
- Minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Attend a Historically Black College and University (HBCU) the semester immediately following high school graduation
- Demonstrated community service and leadership at her high school and in her community, which is clearly reflected in recommendation letters.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- **You should have the following documents ready for upload before you begin this application:**

Essay/Personal Statement

Upload or enter an essay/personal statement which addresses the following questions; essay should be 1,000 words or less.

1. What are your educational and career goals?
2. How will receiving this scholarship assist you in achieving those goals?
3. Choose **ONE** of the following areas and explain how you will use your career to create social change?

Areas: Civic Engagement, Economics, Education, Health, or International Involvement. In addition, you are required to obtain two letters of recommendation and an academic transcript (each in sealed envelopes). These items must be mailed to our office, in one large envelope, and be received no later than **March 23, 2020**.

- **Two Recommendation Letters:**

1. A letter of recommendation from an academic officer (dean, teacher/professor counselor/advisor) must accompany this application.
2. A letter of recommendation from a leader of a civic, community, or Pan-Hellenic organization in your community must accompany this application.

Both letters must be written on official letterhead stationery.
